**WHEREAS** the State Board of Medical Examiners (the Board) has received an initial complaint with respect to Darryl Matthew Sugar, (Respondent), regarding allegations of professional misconduct; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has conducted an investigation regarding possible violations of the Medical Practice Act regarding the Respondent without entering any findings; and

**WHEREAS**, Respondent has advised that he wishes to cease the practice of medicine immediately, waive further proceedings, and give up forevermore the right to practice medicine in South Carolina; and


**WHEREAS**, Respondent understands that he has the right to a hearing and to be represented by counsel in this matter. Respondent is not represented by counsel. Respondent understands and agrees that by entering into this Agreement he voluntarily relinquishes any right to judicial review. Respondent freely, knowingly, and voluntarily waives any and all such rights and further proceedings in this matter. Respondent understands and agrees that he will not be eligible to reapply for a license to practice medicine in this State in the future. Respondent understands and agrees that, once signed, this Agreement is irrevocable on his part and shall not be subject to judicial review; and

**WHEREAS**, it is understood and agreed that, pursuant to the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act, this is a public document.


**THEREFORE**, Respondent does hereby agree to relinquish forevermore his right to practice medicine in South Carolina, effective immediately upon acceptance by the Board.
