**Re: NOTICE OF AUTOMATIC SUSPENSION
PURSUANT TO BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONS CODE SECTION 2310
California License: 20A7355

Dear Dr. Ly:

California Business and Professions Code section 2310 authorizes the Osteopathic Medical Board of California to immediately suspend the California medical license of any osteopathic physician and surgeon whose medical license has been suspended or revoked in any other state or by any agency of the federal government. A copy of Business and Professions Code section 2310 is enclosed for your review.

The Osteopathic Medical Board of California has determined, upon review of certified documents from State of Washington Department of Health, Board of Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery, that your Washington license to practice medicine was suspended on September 22, 2014. Washington Board of Osteopathic Medicine and Surgeon subsequently filed a Second Amended Statement of Charges on May 27, 2015; the suspension remains in place. Based on this suspension, your California medical license has been suspended effective immediately. This action will be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards.

You have a right to a hearing on this issue of penalty, as provided by Business and Professions Code section 2310(c). This hearing will be held within 90 days from the date of your request. You may send this request to:
