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FINAL ORDER DENYING REINSTATEMENT

On January 6, 2017, Petitioner filed with the Michigan Board of Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery (Board) an application for reinstatement of the license to practice as an osteopathic physician in the state of Michigan with supporting documents, in accordance with the provisions of the Mich Admin Code, R 792.10711.

On or about on February 2, 2017, the Department of Attorney General, Licensing and Regulation Division, on behalf of the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Bureau of Professional Licensing (Department), filed a response taking no position on Petitioner's application for reinstatement.

On April 25, 2017, the Board issued an Order Denying Reinstatement.

An administrative hearing was held in the matter before an administrative law judge who, on September 12, 2017, issued a Proposal for Decision (PFD) setting forth recommended Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

The Board, having reviewed the administrative record, considered this

matter, at a regularly scheduled meeting held in Lansing, Michigan on February 1, 2018, and accepted the administrative law judge's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained in the Proposal for Decision. The Board explicitly excluded the issue of unlicensed practice of acupuncture as a basis for their decision.


IT IS ORDERED that Petitioner's application for reinstatement of the license to practice as an osteopathic physician is DENIED, as Petitioner has failed to satisfy the requirements for reinstatement pursuant to MCL 333.16245 and MCL 333.16247, and the guidelines on reinstatement adopted by the Department.

This Order is a public record required to be published and made available to the public pursuant to the Michigan Freedom of Information Act, MCL 15.241(1)(a); and this action may be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank, and any other entity as required by state or federal law, in accordance with 42 USC 11101-11152.
