CONSENT ORDER AND STIPULATION

CONSENT ORDER

An Administrative Complaint (Complaint) was executed on December 9, 2014, charging Anthony Vernon Dallas, Jr., M.D. (Respondent) with violating sections 16221(b)(x) and 16221(f) of the Public Health Code, 1978 PA 368, as amended; MCL 333.1101 et seq; and

Respondent has admitted that the facts alleged in the Complaint are true with the exception of Count II alleging a violation of section 16221(f) of the Public Health Code, supra, which shall be DISMISSED, are true and constitute a violation of the Public Health Code; and

The Disciplinary Subcommittee of the Michigan Board of Medicine (Disciplinary Subcommittee) has reviewed the Consent Order and Stipulation (Order) and agrees that the public interest is best served by resolution of the outstanding Complaint; therefore,

IT IS FOUND that the facts alleged in the Complaint are true and constitute a violation of section 16221(b)(x) of the Public Health Code, supra.

Accordingly,

Pursuant to the attached Stipulation, Count II of the Complaint, which charged Respondent with violating section 16221(f) of the Public Health Code, supra, is DISMISSED.

IT IS ORDERED that for the cited violation of the Public Health Code, Respondent is FINED \$250.00 to be paid to the State of Michigan within 60 days of the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the fine shall be mailed to the **Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Enforcement Division, Sanction Monitoring, P.O. Box 30189, Lansing, MI 48909**. The fine shall be paid by check or money order, made payable to the State of Michigan, and the check or money order shall clearly display file number **43-14-135023**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Respondent violates any provision of this Order, the Disciplinary Subcommittee may proceed to take disciplinary action pursuant to Mich Admin Code, R 338.1632 and section 16221(h) of the Public Health Code, supra.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall be effective 30 days from the date signed by the Disciplinary Subcommittee, as set forth below.

STIPULATION

1. Respondent and Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (Department) agree that Count II of the Complaint, which charged Respondent with violating section 16221(f) of the Public Health Code, supra, shall be DISMISSED by the Disciplinary Subcommittee.

2. The facts alleged in the Complaint are true and constitute a violation of section 16221(b)(x) the Public Health Code, supra.

3. Respondent understands and intends that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent is waiving the right, pursuant to the Public Health Code, the rules promulgated thereunder, and the Administrative Procedures Act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, as amended; MCL 24.201 et seq, to require the Department to prove the charges set forth in the Complaint by presentation of evidence and legal authority, and Respondent is waving the right to appear with an attorney and such witnesses as Respondent may desire to present a defense to the charges.

4. Respondent and the Department further agree that this matter is a public record required to be published and made available to the public pursuant to section 11(1)(a) of the Michigan Freedom of Information Act, 1976 PA 442, as amended; MCL 15.241(1)(a); and this action will be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank, and any other entity as required by state or federal law, in accordance with 42 USC 11101-11152.

5. Factors considered in the formulation of this Consent Order are as follows:

Respondent provided evidence to the Department that Respondent reported the disciplinary action taken by the state of Mississippi on September 4, 2014, within 30 days from the date of the action.




