ORDER WITHDRAWING PROBATION

Hearing having been held on August 24, 2017, on a petition for withdrawal of probation, the Board, by a vote of 4-0, now issues its Order Withdrawing Probation as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. This matter is before the Board on Anthony V. Dallas' ("Respondent") petition for withdrawal of his probation. In its Corrected Final Order Accepting Proposed Settlement Agreement issued on October 1, 2015, the Board placed the Respondent's license to practice medicine in Indiana on indefinite probation with no right to petition for withdrawal of his probation until all his other medical licenses were "free and clear".
2. The Respondent has established that the deficiency that required disciplinary action has been remedied.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Indiana Code section 25-1-9-9(b) states in pertinent part that:

The board may withdraw or modify [a] probation [imposed in a disciplinary proceeding] if it finds, after a hearing, that the deficiency that required disciplinary action has been remedied, or that changed circumstances warrant a modification of the order.
2. Because the Respondent has established that the deficiency that required disciplinary action has been remedied, he qualifies for withdrawal of his probation.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Respondent's petition for withdrawal of his probation is granted and therefore his probation is withdrawn.
